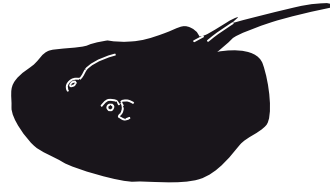


Who Am I?



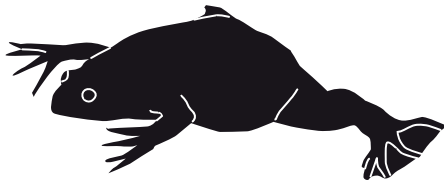
Fish like me have been around since well before the dinosaurs. I am also known as a dragon fish



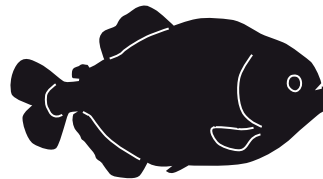
I eat off the bottom of the Amazon River and I have a spine on my tail.



I come from Africa and I am special because I can bury myself in the mud during the dry season breathe air above the water's surface.



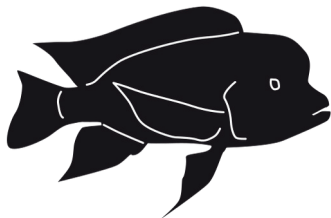
You won't find me hopping on land, instead I prefer floating in the water.
